GIOACHINO ROSSINI

Rossini composed his *Petite Messe solennelle* in 1863 for the inauguration of a private chapel belonging to a wealthy Parisian nobleman. This explains the reduced instrumental scoring. Yet it is precisely this chamber-like instrumentation, reminiscent of refined salon music, that lends the work its distinctive timbre, further enhanced by Rossini's characteristic rhythmic flair.

Beethoven's first major liturgical work was not written on his own initiative. It was commissioned by Prince Esterházy – Joseph Haydn's longtime patron – who wanted a Mass for his wife's name day. For several years, Haydn had fulfilled this annual task, but in the spring of 1807 the honorable commission was entrusted to Beethoven. Although the prince was reportedly unimpressed by the composition, Beethoven stood by his work, and today the *Mass in C* is an indispensable part of the choral-symphonic repertoire. Thankfully!

Beethoven repeatedly referred to his Missa solemnis as his greatest work, one that, "from the heart," was meant to touch and move humanity. Surviving sources reveal how intensively he worked on the composition, striving to give the text an expression that was, in his view, truly fitting. The choir plays a central role in the work, tasked with passages of considerable technical and musical demands.

Frieder Bernius and Uwe Wolf have produced an edition that seeks, with the utmost respect for the surviving material, to make performances possible without obscuring Mozart's musical voice. The version is grounded in deep knowledge of the composer's work, his notational habits, and the liturgical practices of his time - and fully meets the demands of modern performance practice.

Autograph additions from the conductor's score have been included, while detailed editorial notes provide insight into the disparities between sources. Bruckner's Mass in F Minor is one of the most significant works of 19th-century choral literature. With remarkable depth, the composer succeeds in musically embodying the tenets of faith, venturing into extreme realms of expression. This boldness led to tensions with musicians during preparations for the planned 1868 premiere. Over time, however, the work gained increasing popularity and today represents a richly rewarding challenge for accomplished choirs.

CHARLES GOUNOD

Messe brève no. 7 aux chapelles CG 72b

Though best remembered today for his opera *Faust*, Gounod's true artistic focus lay in the field of church music. His sacred œuvre dwarfs that of his French contemporaries. The *Messe brève No. 7* was originally published for two equal voices and organ. In 1890, Gounod produced a revised version under the subtitle *aux chapelles*, arranged for soloists, four-part mixed choir, and organ. This allowed for a significantly richer and more varied sound palette. A Carus classic!

A Mass setting by a young Viennese composer: In 1760, at just 16 years old, Marianna von Martines wrote her Seconda Messa. Martines was greatly encouraged as a child; her teachers included the young Joseph Haydn. Composed in the galant style, the Mass is modest in scale, lasting around thirty minutes. It is a work that can also be performed effectively by a small ensemble.

LUIGI CHERUBINI

How does a composer apply for a position at court? With your own music, of course! When Cherubini sought to succeed Joseph Haydn at the court of the Hungarian Prince Esterházy in 1810, his calling card was the Messe solennelle in D minor. Expansive and rather opulent, the work amply showcased his compositional talents. The new edition is a fantastic introduction to this multifaceted sacred work, which bridges the Classical and Romantic eras.

With his final two *Missae breves*, the *Missa Sancti Nicolai* (Carus 40.605) and the *Missa Sancti Joannis de Deo*, Haydn created two masterpieces that were already among the most popular exemplars of the genre during his lifetime. The *Missa Sancti Joannis de Deo* is rather short, with a level of difficulty rated as easy and a captivating, almost magical expressiveness.

As Kapellmeister of the Royal Court Theatre in Dresden, Carl Maria von Weber's primary focus was, of course, opera. Yet he also regularly fulfilled his duties in the sacred realm. His *Missa sancta No. 2* (nicknamed the "Jubilation Mass") was composed for the church service to celebrate the golden wedding anniversary of the Saxon royal couple in 1819. The choral parts of the Missa are well-suited for amateur choirs looking for celebratory work to mark special occasions in worship or in concert.

The story about the *Missa Papae Marcelli* being performed at the Council of Trent (1545–1563) and "saving" polyphony in church music is nothing more than a charming legend. Nevertheless, this Mass has become symbolic of the Council, which gave significant impetus to the Catholic Counter-Reformation and thus shaped the culture – and with it, the music – of the following century. The individual parts of the mass are also available in separate editions, offering choirs who are not (yet) familiar with the period a good opportunity to explore Palestrina's style.

Want to bring some operatic drama to the church choir? Mascagni's Messa di Gloria for soloists, chorus, and orchestra is the perfect choice. This richly sonorous work combines a simple yet powerful style with sophisticated lyrical melodies for tenor and bass, supported by the choir in the most vigorous movements. The level of difficulty is moderate, and the orchestration is relatively modest, making it an excellent option for youth choirs and orchestras as well.

Schubert's Mass in G major is one of the most popular settings of the Mass Ordinary. Its charming, song-like melodies - especially in the Kyrie and Credo - offer a magical counterpoint to the more concertante passages in the Gloria and Sanctus. The Carus edition, featuring optional trumpets and timpani but no woodwind parts, reflects Schubert's original instrumentation. A version for choir and organ (Carus 40.675/45) is also available.

Verdi's Messa da Requiem is one of the definitive Requiem settings, appearing at the very top of many choirs' wish lists. Premiered in 1874 at Milan Cathedral, Verdi pushes musical boundaries in service of a liturgy dramatized through powerful musical expression. The work is available from Carus in its original form as well as in two arrangements: for chamber orchestra (Carus 27.308) and for small ensemble (Carus 27.303/50).

Composed in 1878, Saint-Saëns' Messe de Requiem is a vibrant and opulently orchestrated work. He wrote it in memory of his friend and patron Albert Libon, whose legacy enabled Saint-Saëns to pursue a career as a composer. To make the work accessible for smaller ensembles without sacrificing its distinctive sound, the edition includes an optional orchestral reduction. Additionally, an arrangement for strings, harp, and organ is available (Carus 27.317/50).

The most renowned Requiem setting prior to Mozart's comes from opera composer Niccolò Jommelli. Written in the Neapolitan style, Jommelli's Missa pro defunctis features a modest scoring for strings and basso continuo. The choral writing is simple yet effective: partly polyphonic in the stile antico, partly shaped by solo/tutti contrasts and expressive suspensions. The solo passages unmistakably bear the signature of an opera composer. Carus is now publishing for the first time a complete critical edition of this beautiful Missa.

Carus not only offers the classics of choral symphonic repertoire but is also steadily expanding its contemporary catalog. A recent addition is the *Requiem* by British composer Grayston (Bill) Ives, a onetime tenor with the legendary King's Singers, who later served at Magdalen College, Oxford. The *Requiem* was composed for the college's 550th anniversary and is well-suited for both liturgical use and concert performance. Ives' musical language is tonal, straightforward, yet varied and full of surprises, such as the striking use of Tibetan hand cymbals.
