Né à Glarus (Suisse) le 4 septembre 1965. Études à l'Université de Zurich (lettres modernes et latines, musicologie). Il enseigne la flûte traversière au lycée « Alte Kantonsschule Aarau ».

Cours divers à l'Ircam (Paris), entre autres le cours d'été en informatique musicale. 1994–2003 directeur artistique du festival international « Tage für Neue Musik Zürich ». 1999 Prix de composition de la Ville de Zurich. 2003 Prix de la fondation d'État Pro Arte. Collaboration étroite (en tant que flûtiste et compositeur) avec le chorégraphe Gabriel Hernández (tHEL danse) à Paris. Sa liste d'œuvres comprend des compositions du solo à l'orchestre, principalement de la musique de chambre, avec ou sans électronique.

Sommerkurs in Musikinformatik. 1994–2003 künstlerischer Leiter des internationalen Festivals „Tage für Neue Musik Zürich“. 1999 Komponistenwerkjahr der Stadt Zürich. 2002 Förderpreis der Stiftung Pro Arte. Enge Zusammenarbeit (als Komponist und Flötist) mit dem Choreographen Gabriel Hernández tHEL danse Paris. Seine Werkliste umfasst Kompositionen vom Solo- bis zum Orchesterwerk, mit Schwergewicht auf der Kammermusik, mit oder ohne Live-Elektronik.

Walter Feldmann

Born in Glarus, Switzerland, 4 September 1965. Studied French, Latin, and musicology at Zürich University. Taught flute at the lycée "Alte Kantonsschule Aarau."

Various courses at Ircam, Paris, including a summer course in music informatics. 1994–2003 Artistic Director of the international festival "Tage für Neue Musik Zürich." 1999 awarded "Komponistenwerkjahr" (stipend) by the city of Zürich. 2002 awarded a young artist's fellowship from the Pro Arte Foundation. Has worked closely (as a composer and flutist) with the choreographer Gabriel Hernández of tHEL danse Paris. His works encompass compositions ranging from solo pieces to orchestral works, with an emphasis on chamber music – with or without live electronics.
